I. Call to Order

II. Approval of Previous Meeting's Minutes

A motion was made to approve the September 7, 2016 Board Meeting Minutes. The motion was moved by Scott Little, seconded by Chris Antonucci. The motion passed unanimously, 5:0.

III. New Business

Executive Director Jason Vitaich delivered the following report:

- Preparation for 2017 dues increase information dissemination is going well, with a
 timeline in place for a membership forum and subsequent electronic communications
 through the first quarter of 2017. An informal Coffee Hour for members to express any
 concerns as well as ask any questions has been set up for Wednesday, November 9th,
 2016.
- The following program changes will be implemented in 2017, per Board Discussion;
 - -increase in the amount of the RT Subsidy from \$50 to \$75, while decreasing the number of subsidies of this type awarded from 20 to 10 per month, based upon usage trends;
 - -a consolidation of the 2 capital improvements programs into a single program, reducing the overall money allocated for cap programs in 2017 to \$30,000 total, as opposed to the \$45,000 allocated in 2016, based upon usage trends;
 - -an increase in the number of carpool subsidies awarded each month from 35 to 50, based upon usage trends;
 - -an increase in the number or low emissions vehicle subsidies from 20 to 25, based upon usage trends
