- 1. Any SNTMA member employee may apply to receive of up to a \$1000 residential car charging station subsidy under this program providing their employer is an SNTMA member.
- 2. Qualified applicants must be registered the Sacramento Region Commuter Club at http://www.sacregioncommuterclub.org with their work email address. Once logged into the Commuter Club one can learn the guidelines and apply for SNTMA subsidies under TMA Subsidies on the right side of the page.
- 3. Due to the limited number of funds, Residential Car Charger Subsidies will be awarded on a first come, first serve basis.
- 4. As a condition of funding, recipients will upload a receipt for the charging station installation and a photo of the installed charging station to be posted on the SNTMA web site and Facebook page. The receipt for the charging station must be dated within 90 days of the subsidy request.
- 5. This subsidy cannot be combined with any other incentives.
- Only one residential car charging station per SNTMA member company employee household.
- 7. Subject to SNTMA Board of Directors approval.
